Show Program Notes:

- All results MUST be legible and made out properly. The front page of this form along with USEF's horse show record or Saddle Horse Report show record will be accepted as an entry.
- Maximum of 5 shows count in each submitted category except for Promotion. Minimum of 3 placings at shows must be submitted for each category.
- Complete listing of categories and information regarding the NYSMHS High Score Award Program is listed in the Membership Directory.
- Jr. Exhibitor Saddle Seat includes Park, English Pleasure & Classic Pleasure seats. If Jr. Exh./Horse combo participate in multiple seats – seat with the highest points will be counted.
- Amateur & Jr. Exhibitor Pleasure Driving have been combined into a single category.
- Classic Pleasure Driving Category now includes Amateurs and Jr. Exhibitors.
- Equitation Category is now a single category; no longer split by age.
- Points earned at 4H shows will be included in the Promotion Category.
- Park Saddle & Harness includes open and amateur classes.

Dressage Notes:

- Minimum of 3 shows.
- For Western Dressage - 5 scores at the same level (*including Introductory Level*) with an average of at least 55%.
- For Traditional Dressage - If 2nd Level or below (*excluding Introductory Level*), 5 scores at the same level with an average of at least 55%; at least 2 of which must be for the highest test at level.
- For Traditional Dressage - If 3rd Level or above, 3 scores with an average of at least 55%; at least 1 score of which must be for the highest test at level.
- Musical freestyle tests are deemed to be the equivalent of the highest test at level.
- Minimum of 2 different Judges.
- For Western Dressage - Shows need not be recognized, but judges must be at least a USDF "L" graduate.
- For Traditional Dressage - Shows must be recognized and judges be rated.
- If NYSMHS sponsors an unrecognized (schooling) show (Traditional and/or Western), that show will be deemed a recognized show and the judge rated provided the judge is a least a USDF "L" graduate.
- Substantiation of submitted scores must be included with entry. Sufficient substantiation includes a copy of the front of the test sheet along with relevant pages of show's prize list to confirm that show is recognized and the judge is rated; sufficient substantiation also includes a copy of the USDF "Horse Score Check" or other similar documentation
- Judges' names and scores must be legible.
- Shows need not be Morgan Shows.
- Complete listing of scoring criteria & calculation method regarding the NYSMHS Dressage High Score Award Program is listed in the Membership Directory.
